CULTIVAL BEHIND THE SCENE ...

Cultival is a genuine cultural outings agency, bringing together professionals who are passionate about culture and performing arts.

The agency was created 15 years ago with the aim of helping visitors discover what goes on behind the scenes of Parisian Theatres. Among the first theatres that joined us in this adventure were the Théâtre des Variétés, the Opéra Comique, the Théâtre Marigny, the Théâtre de la Porte Saint-Martin and the Théâtre des Bouffes-Parisiens.

These backstage tours have quickly become very popular, with a special success among organised group visits. The concept is so successful that barely 4 years after its creation, Cultival has been

entrusted with the management of the Palais Garnier guided tours. The agency then went on to design an exclusive and unique Behind the Scenes Tour of the Eiffel Tower. This has been followed by the Cité des Sciences et de l'Industrie, the Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle, the Fondation Pierre Bergé - Yves Saint Laurent, the Hôtel des Invalides, The Cité du Cinéma...

As a tourist and cultural operator, today Cultival is trusted by 25 Parisian monuments administrating their operations, bookings and marketing politics. The team consists of 25 members of full time staff and up to 100 field workers (such as certificated guides) who authenticate and share the history of these legendary places.

Discover the symbol of Medieval Paris away from the crowds and time restrictions, outside normal opening times. A Gothic masterpiece, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will start your guided tour on the famous square in front of the cathedral, from where you can admire its sumptuous façade. Next you will visit the famous towers after opening hours! Having climbed up over 400 steps you will be rewarded by one of the most beautiful panoramic views over Paris. Before reaching the summit, you can admire the upper room and its Gothic architecture.

Formerly royal residence in Paris up to the 14th century, the Conciergerie was used to imprison famous defendants during the Revolution, including Marie-Antoinette who spent her final days here.

Delve into the Reign of Terror, exploring the dungeons used to imprison unfortunate victims and the detention methods of the revolutionary court. You will also discover the blade of the ominous guillotine.



In 1861, at Napoleon III's request, Charles Garnier started building a new Opera House. The monument still captivates everyone thanks to its rich, eclectic and daring architecture and baroque ornaments. In one hour your guide will explain 1001 wonders and marvels about this temple of classical music.

Then, your tour will continue at the Fragonard Museum, located in front of the Opera. You will discover an impressive collection of perfumery objects which will make you travel across different historical periods of this tender olfactory world.








MONTMARTRE MUSEUM, THE PARIS OF ARTISTS



Located in the heart of Montmartre, Espace Dalí displays the only collection dedicated to the Master of surrealism, and particulary to his sculptures, etchings and lithographies. At Espace Dalí, you will travel around a fantastical world as you will discover over 300 masterpieces that turned Dalí into an iconic figure of the 20th century. Inspired by his most famous paintings, the Space Elephant reveals Dalí's technical skills, his flourishing imagination and his surrealist vision in 3-D. Mae West's lips sofa, a glamorous actress of the 1920's as well as Dalí's living room and his muse Gala are among the many masterpieces you will discover along the tour. 

Montmartre, a historic and touristic area, was not always as it is today. Poor, dangerous and frivolous, this out-of-town spot which acted as a refuge for marginalised artists and was the birthplace of several artistic movements, is now one of the most beautiful areas of Paris and an entertainment hotspot. This visit will take you back through time and history. Firstly, you will discover the Renoir gardens, named in honour of the painter and a real haven of peace overlooking the last remaining vines and the site of the famous paintings 'Dance at the Moulin de la Galette', 'The Swing' and 'The Gardens of rue Cortot'. Your guide will then take you to an 18th century residence, home to a whole host of souvenirs and collections: the French Cancan, Shadow theatre, cabarets with the famous Chat Noir and the arrival of the Moulin Rouge. Your visit will then take you to the famous workshop-flat where Suzanne Valadon and her son Maurice Utrillon lived. This astonishing reconstruction opened in October 2014 immerses visitors into the atmosphere of artists' workshops where paintings, palettes and easels intertwine, offering a breathtaking view over the city of light.



Enter the Celestins district and come discover the training area of the cavalrymen of the French Republican Guard. Constructed in 1895, the district houses the headquarters and the cavalry regiment of the French Republican Guard. You will be captivated by the magnificent Eiffel Tower style structure of the riding stables where the cavalrymen train daily. Inside the Main Stable and the Major's Stable your guide will explain the characteristics of the majestic horses. An unusual guided tour in the heart of Paris that takes you behind the scenes of the cavalry of the Republican Guard.

Do not approach the horses at less than one metre • Be careful about allergies due to the presence of horses as well as the storage of fodder and cereals • During the winter season, we don't have access to the forge after 4 p.m. • You can take pictures without a flash







The tour of the crypt will allow you to meet 75 illustrious personalities who were buried here between the French Revolution and the Fifth Republic. Among them Voltaire, Jean-Jacques Rousseau, Victor Hugo, Andre Malraux and Pierre and Marie Curie. It is in homage to these great men that a dozen famous artists contributed to the interior decoration of the monument whose architecture is inspired by ancient Greek art.
