Discover the Eiffel Tower like you have never seen it before! Your guided tour will start in the bunker under the Champ de Mars. As a privileged visitor, you will have backstage access to the engine room where your guide will tell you more about the hydraulic system process which controls the Eiffel Tower's elevators. You will then go to the second floor where you will reach the roof of the famous restaurant Le Jules Verne. You will be seduced by this amazing view!

For logistic reason, it is mandatory to be at the meeting point 15 minutes before the tour starts. This tour includes the ticket up to the 2nd floor. Tickets for the 3rd floor may be purchased at the end of the tour from the ticket counter on the 2nd floor. This tour is not available for children aged 5 years and below. High heeled shoes are strongly unadvised on this tour. The bunker and/or the roof of the Jules Verne may not be accessible. Cultival cannot be responsible for waiting times caused by a large number of visitors, or any technical problems that could change the course of the visit on the tour date itself.

# TOWERS OF NOTRE-DAME CATHEDRAL • AFTER HOURS



Discover the symbol of Medieval Paris away from the crowds and time restrictions, outside normal opening times. A Gothic masterpiece, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will start your guided tour on the famous square in front of the cathedral, from where you can admire its sumptuous façade. Next you will visit the famous towers after opening hours! Having climbed up over 400 steps you will be rewarded by one of the most beautiful panoramic views over Paris. Before reaching the summit, you can admire the upper room and its Gothic architecture.



Formerly royal residence in Paris up to the 14th century, the Conciergerie was used to imprison famous defendants during the Revolution, including Marie-Antoinette who spent her final days here.

Delve into the Reign of Terror, exploring the dungeons used to imprison unfortunate victims and the detention methods of the revolutionary court. You will also discover the blade of the ominous quillotine.
