### THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE THE PARIS OF ARTISTS

#### 60 min open visit Maximum capacity: 40 • Ages: 6 > 17 yrs old

In a setting of Parisian vivacity, students will go and discover this museum, where they will be taken on a journey into the history of Montmartre, a centre for artistic creativity. On the programme: discovery of paintings, posters and drawings by Toulouse-Lautrec, Modigliani, Kupka, Steinlen, a visit to the Renoir Gardens and Suzanne Valadon's studio-apartment.

Temporary exhibition from October 18, 2016 to March 5, 2017: 'Bernard Buffet, intimement'.

Come and see what it's like in the artists' workshops where canvases fight for space with palettes and easels.

# THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE AROUND THE POSTERS OF MONTMARTRE

90 min workshop (30 min guided tour followed by a 60 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 6 > 12 yrs old

The tour will uncover the most popular posters of Montmartre, such as Le Chat Noir by Steinlen, the Moulin Rouge by Toulouse-Lautrec and many others, such as those dedicated to propaganda during the Paris Commune of 1871. The workshop that follows introduce children to the ways of making a poster. How do you make such a poster? What codes should be followed? How do you choose colours, fonts, titles, images, text and symbols... in order to create an attractive poster and meet the advertising codes revealed during the visit.

For the workshop, students must be put into small groups of 3 and 4 before the visit. Wear an old t-shirt. Each child will have a role to play in this task. The class will leave with the poster they create during the workshop.

# THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE THE ANIMALS OF THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE

#### 90 min workshop (30 min guided tour followed by a 60 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 4 > 5 yrs old

Over the course of a fun 30-minute visit in the museum or the gardens, depending on the weather, children will discover the different animals that inspired the most famous posters of Montmartre. The children will learn all there is to know about Le Chat Noir and the Lapin Agile. This interactive visit will be followed by a creative workshop during which children can let their imaginations run wild and their creativity shine through, by putting their artistic skills into practice. Drawing, painting, sticking... anything goes when re-creating the animals studied during the visit or those straight out of their own imaginations.

### THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE THE FLOWERS OF VALADON

90 min workshop (30 min guided tour followed by a 60 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 6 > 12 yrs old

A 30-minute guided tour during which children can learn about Suzanne Valadon, the first female painter of the Butte Montmartre, who was a major influence on the artists of this area. During the workshop, which follows the visit, children will discover the artist's paintings, especially her floral compositions. Inspired by her work, children will then create their own masterpieces using several materials: tissue paper, coloured paper, pencils and charcoal. Wear on old t-shirt.

# THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE RENOIR

90 min workshop (30 min guided tour followed by a 60 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 8 > 10 yrs old

This workshop visit begins in the Renoir Gardens, named after the famous painter who lived temporarily in the museum. Your tour guide will talk about the artist's life, what inspired him, his love for the gardens, light and nature and his quick brushstroke style called impressionism. During the workshop, children can choose an existing work or something right out of their imaginations. They will learn about impressionism: how light and shade can be created with small coloured strokes and why you should gradually reduce the strokes as you paint.

The children will learn every last detail about Renoir. The class will leave with the canvas they create during the workshop.

# THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE VIEWS AND LANDSCAPES OF THE MUSEUM

90 min workshop (30 min guided tour followed by a 60 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 6 > 10 yrs old

This workshop teaches children about the artistic zest of Montmartre in the 19th and 20th centuries. Using Raoul Dufy, a resident of Montmartre and pioneer of Fauvism, as a reference, students will learn about his artistic method: the unnatural colours, the speed of his movements and the way he puts personal feelings onto canvas. The students will then have a go at expressing their emotions and dreams through painting. On canvas, they can paint the landscape they hope to admire every day when they open their curtains.

Relive the spirit of the most famous shadow theatre in Montmartre, letting children discover the silhouettes of the Chat Noir! After a visit of the museum where they will discover the unique collection of zinc decorations from the Chat Noir shadow theatre, children will learn the underlying technical principles and the influence of Japanese prints on art at the end of the 19th century. During the workshop, they will go back to the Belle Époque, participating in their own little show based on artists who have lived on the Butte de Montmartre, then create their own silhouettes.

### THE MUSEUM OF MONTMARTRE MY IMPRESSIONIST GARDEN

#### 90 min workshop (30 min guided tour followed by a 60 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 4 > 6 yrs old

Create your first impressionist works inspired by the pretty museum gardens! During a short visit to the legendary workshop of 12 rue Cortot, children will discover and learn about the lives of artists who lived in the museum at the end of the 19th century. Whilst they walk across the gardens, they will question them, getting to know the impressionist palette, and the famous Pierre-Auguste Renoir, who painted several paintings here, found today in the Musée d'Orsay. 

The guide will begin their journey at the heart of Salvador Dali's imagination and works by introducing students to the foundations of surrealism and sculpture. The techniques of lost wax casting or using molten glass will be explained here so that during the workshop, each pupil can give free rein to their imagination when creating a clay sculpture of their own self-portrait.

90 min workshop (45 min guided tour followed by a 45 min workshop) Maximum capacity: 30 • Ages: 7 > 17 yrs old

Using images of Dali's works or portrait photos of the artist, students will create an anamorphosis, by creating an optical illusions experiment. After a 45 minute visit during which students will discover Dali's universe, his personality and the major works of the collection, students will have the possibility in the workshop to choose an image and create a cylindrical anamorphosis that they can take away with them at the end of the activity.

### ESPACE DALÍ JOANN SFAR - SALVADOR DALÍ, A SECOND BEFORE AWAKENING

Carte blanche was given to Joann Sfar, one of the most talented contemporary storytellers (known to the public for The Rabbi's Cat and his film Gainsbourg: A Heroic Life) to imagine the scenario of an artistic meeting with Dalí. More than 200 original drawings are to be discovered in a delightful setting of Dalí's sculptures and surrealist objects and Haute Couture creations by Schiaparelli that inspired the artist.

The temporary exhibition Joann Sfor - Salvador Dalí, une seconde avant l'éveil' takes place from September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016 to March 31<sup>th</sup>, 2017. Attention: certain texts or drawings may offend the sensibilities of a young audience.

An invitation to a 'motionless voyage' of a painter and his models moving between dream and reality, over the course of Joann Sfar's writing and drawings.













### EIFFEL TOWER BEHIND THE SCENES OF THE EIFFEL TOWER

The guide will take children behind the scenes of this monument, unveiling its secrets along the way. They will be able to access spaces that are normally closed to the public, such as the engine room, which still controls the operation of the lifts... The guided tour will end with an ascent to the 2nd floor of the tower, 115 metres high, on the roof of Le Jules Verne restaurant, where they will be able to take in breath-taking and unique views of all of Paris.

# REPUBLICAN GUARD THE LARGER THAN LIFE CAVALIERS

90 min guided tour Maximum capacity: 25 • Ages: 12 > 17 yrs old

Children will venture into the Célestins quarter to discover this legendary place built in 1895, home since then to the general staff and the Calvary regiment of the Republican Guard. A tour of the stables home to 140 horses and an immersion in a room full of the traditions dedicated to the history of the Republican Guard are on the agenda for this quirky guided tour.

The Republican Guard is a professional place; the riders are not obliged to train during the tours. Do not approach the horses from less than 1 metre away.

Children will discover the cavaliers and the horses that participate in the 14th July parade!

# PARISIAN DISTRICTS A STROLL IN ILE DE LA CITÉ

This is a walk that will span the ages and retrace the history of the capital's origins. Known as the 'cradle of Paris', the Ile de la Cité has been around for nearly 20 centuries. The visit will begin at the Place du Châtelet, a tribute to Napoleon's victories, and will continue to the Quai des Orfèvres, the Palais de Justice, the Conciergerie, and will finish by crossing the oldest stone bridge in Paris: the Pont Neuf.

The guide will explain along the way, taking children to the doors of the Academy of Medicine, the Paris School of Fine Arts and the Hôtel de la Monnaie.

They will then take the old weavers street and here discover the exceptional architecture of several mansions, for the most part converted into museums.

C This is a neighbourhood stroll that revisits the eras and retraces the evolution of this neighbourhood from Renaissance times to Henri IV, through to the Revolution and then the present day.

### BERCY VILLAGE A WALK IN BERCY VILLAGE

90 min guided tour Maximum capacity: 25 • Ages: 8 > 17 yrs old

The guide will retrace the history of Bercy Village, the world's first wine marketplace: the cellars that remain are evidence of the huge wine warehouses that occupied hundreds of hectares crossing the Parc de Bercy. This visit will continue with the flagship buildings of the area such as the Cinémathèque française, or the AccorHotel, fantastic symbols of Parisian architecture.
