

The agency was created over 14 years ago with the aim of helping visitors discover what goes on behind the scenes of Paris' Theatres. The first to join the adventure were le Théâtre des Variétés, l'Opéra Comique, le Théâtre Marigny, la Porte Saint-Martin and le Théâtre des Bouffes Parisiens.

These backstage tour experiences quickly became widely successful, especially with organised groups. So successful that barely 4 years after its creation, Cultival has been entrusted with the management of Palais Garnier's guided tours. The agency then went on to design an exclusive and unique behind the scenes tour of the Eiffel Tower. This has been followed by la Cité des Sciences et de l'Industrie, le Lido de Paris, le Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle, la Fondation Pierre Bergé - Yves Saint Laurent, l'Hôtel des Invalides and others.

As a tourism and cultural operator, Cultival now administers the operation, booking and marketing for more than 30 collaborating monuments in Paris, with whom a strong spirit of trust is maintained. The team consists of 30 members of staff and up to 100 field workers who authenticate and share the history of these legendary places.



BEHIND THE SCENES OF THE EIFFEL TOWER











Discover the Eiffel Tower like you have never seen it before! Your guided tour will start in the bunker under the Champ de Mars. As a privileged visitor, you will have backstage access to the engine room where your guide will tell you more about the hydraulic system process which controls the Eiffel Tower's elevators. You will then go to the second floor where you will reach the roof of the famous restaurant Le Jules Verne. You will be seduced by this amazing view!

This tour includes the ticket up to the 2^{nd} floor • Tickets for the 3^{rd} floor may be purchased at the end of the tour from the ticket counter on the 2nd floor • This tour is not available for children aged of 5 years old and below • High heeled shoes are strongly unadvised on this tour • The bunker and/or the roof of the Jules Verne may not be accessible for all tour departures after 19h30.

TOWERS OF NOTRE-DAME CATHEDRAL • AFTER HOURS












Discover the symbol of Medieval Paris away from the crowds and time restrictions, outside normal opening times. A Gothic masterpiece, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. You will start your guided tour on the famous square in front of the cathedral, from where you can admire its sumptuous façade. Next you will visit the famous towers after opening hours! Having climbed up over 400 steps you will be rewarded by one of the most beautiful panoramic views over Paris. Before reaching the summit, you can admire the upper room and its Gothic architecture.

Due to works, access to the south belfry and the Emmanuel tenor bell is closed until further notice • The visit includes 422 steps without lift • Due to narrow stairs and some passages, this tour is highly not recommended for overweight people and pregnant women.




OPERA GARNIER • DAY TOUR

FRENCH OPERA & PERFUMES











Cultival invites you to undertake a romantic and artistic tour in the heart of the Opera District. You will start your guided tour at the emblematic Opera Garnier before visiting the splendid Fragonard Museum. In 1861, at Napoleon III's request, Charles Garnier started building a new Opera House. The monument still captivates everyone thanks to its rich, eclectic and daring architecture and baroque ornaments. In one hour your guide will explain 1001 wonders and marvels about this temple of classical music. Then, the tour will continue at the Fragonard Museum, located in front of the Opera. It was built during the same period by a student of Charles Garnier! Painted ceilings, parquet floors, romantic stuccos, chimneys and chandeliers date back to the construction of the building which is partly listed as a historical monument. You will discover an impressive collection of perfumery objects which will make you travel across different historical periods.



ARC DE TRIOMPHE • SKIP THE LINE ACCESS TO SUMMIT











Your guide will take you on the discovery of the sculptures and bas reliefs that adorn the Arc de Triomphe, symbols of the French Empire. You will be immersed in the key moments of the French History such as Napoleon's death (1821), the victory parade (1919), the liberation of Paris (1944)...

The tour will end at 55 meters high, in the center of the historic axis connecting the Louvre to the Arch of La Defense. Finally, look down and admire the stars formed by the blocks of colour on the Place de l'Etoile!




SECRETS OF LES INVALIDES











This unusual guided tour will offer you the opportunity to enter into the heart of the « Hôtel National des Invalides » in Paris, into areas that are normally closed to the public. You will discover anecdotes, unusual facts and legends all along the tour. Your guide will begin with a presentation of the history and architecture of Les Invalides, allowing you to get an insight of the daily routine of the residents who lived there back in the 17th century. Your guided tour will then continue in the Cathedral Saint-Louis des Invalides and areas that are normally closed to the public, where you will discover unusual stories related to the French Revolution as well as the mysterious presence of Rouget de Lisle at Les Invalides.

Your guided tour will end at the monumental Dome Church in which the grave of Napoleon I is housed, under its magnificent golden cupola.







THE CAVALRY OF THE FRENCH REPUBLICAN GUARD











Enter the Celestins district and come discover the training area of the cavalrymen of the French Republican Guard. Constructed in 1895, the district houses the headquarters and the cavalry regiment of the French Republican Guard.

You will be captivated by the magnificent Eiffel Tower style structure of the riding stables where the cavalrymen train daily. Inside the Main Stable and the Major's Stable your guide will explain the characteristics of the majestic horses. An unusual guided tour in the heart of Paris that takes you behind the scenes of the cavalry of the Republican Guard.

Do not approach the horses at less than one metre • Be careful about allergies due to the presence of horses as well as the storage of fodder and cereals • During the winter season, we don't have access to the forge after 4 p.m. • You can take pictures without a flash





What is the best way to learn the history and the richness of the French capital, than by learning about its most emblematic districts? From the Palais Royal, your guide will carry you along the Galerie Vero Dodat with its beautiful art bookshops and onwards to the Galerie Vivienne, one of the most majestic passages with Italian mosaics on the floor and a glass roof. The Galerie Vivienne will lead you to the Galerie Colbert, where exhibitions are regularly organized. Philatelists will appreciate the Passage des Panoramas leading to the Grands Boulevards made famous by Yves Montand's songs.

Very popular in the 19th century as the fastest way to the Grands Boulevards from the Palais Royal, the thirty remaining roofed passageways (formerly 140) enable you to plunge into a « time warp », cut off from street bustle. Today, one can find all kinds of shops here, as well as some cafés and especially, the remnants of a recent past where strolling and parading oneself was an essential activity of daily life.
